



In accordance with state rules and regulations promulgated by the Missouri Public Service Commission, and as outlined in 4 CSR 240-20.065 Net Metering, which deals with net metering in Missouri, any customer who operates a distributed generation unit parallel to an electric utility and who intends to sell back to that utility any electric energy which is in excess of their own usage is required to pay for all costs of special hardware and metering for installation and operation of the distributed generation unit. Any amount paid is considered "Aid to Construction" and is non-refundable. The cost of special metering to record the electric energy which both flows into and out of the primary meter is approximately \$550. A standard meter is \$150. The difference is \$400.

Co-Mo Electric Cooperative is willing to waive this extra metering charge in exchange for the right to meter, record, use and disseminate to others at its sole discretion any information acquired from the distributed generation unit, and to place all meters or other necessary equipment to accomplish same. Reasonable access to all meters and equipment used in the collection of the aforementioned information shall be provided to Co-Mo Electric Cooperative personnel, but on no less than a monthly basis.

Co-Mo Electric Cooperative by way of this agreement shall not accept any responsibility for the inspection, operation, maintenance or general oversight of the distributed generation unit.
